

QUICK PROTECTOR BERM

Quick Protector Berms offer quick, reliable secondary containment. Their inside stays are incredibly easy to raise and lower when you need to drive in or out. They're also built out of durable, chemical resistant fabric you can depend on.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

SITE PREP

1. Clear a deployment area of debris that might damage the berm.

DEPLOYMENT

1. Unfold the berm.
2. Lift the berm walls and flip the inside stays into place.
3. Pull the staking straps to the outside of the berm.
4. Drive stakes through the grommets in the staking straps.

REPAIR

1. Clean the area to be patched using denatured alcohol.

Note: Patches should always be applied to the inside of the berm.

2. Cut out the patch material, rounding the corners so that they don't peel up.
3. Peel the paper backing from the adhesive patch.
4. Center the patch over the hole.
5. Apply the patch in a rolling motion.
6. Rub out any bubbles.



AFTER USE

1. Drain the berm according to environmental regulations.
2. Collapse the stays.
3. Fold the berm.
4. Store in a dry place, protected from the sun and rodents.
